- **Heroes at Home** - Thanks to the partnership between Sears Holdings and Rebuilding Together, RTD received a fall grant for two projects for repairs/modifications for two military veterans and their families. Major bathroom repairs will be completed for a family in West Carrollton and a ramp will be built for a couple in Union. Work will take place in September. This is the third Heroes at Home grant RTD has received.

- **Rebuilding Together's CapacityCorps Program** - Rebuilding Together Dayton was recently awarded an AmeriCorps position for a handyman to perform minor home repairs. Shane Sergent starts work with us on September 15 after training in New Orleans. Shane will receive a monthly stipend and an education award upon completion of ten months of service.

- **Summer at Rebuilding Together** - Many people think RTD is "only" about National Rebuilding Day, the last Saturday in April. While that is our big community-involved event, many other homeowners are assisted throughout the rest of the year. In addition to the hundreds of projects completed by NeighborCare's skilled trades-people with our year round program, many volunteer groups work with us over the summer. Thanks to volunteers from HSBC/ Household Finance, Catholic Heart Work Camp, Summer of Service, Carroll High School, Belmont United Methodist Youth, Fairhaven Church and UD's Program for Christian Leadership, dozens of homeowners received paint jobs, repairs and yard work.
