- **Spread the Spirit Award** - Rebuilding Together Dayton received the Grand Prize for our latest video at Rebuilding Together's national conference held recently in Washington D.C. "100,000 Stories: Rebuilding Together" united over 300 representatives from affiliates across the country to share stories and ideas. Mike Kurtz of University of Dayton's Media Production Group did an outstanding job of producing the video. - **More National News** - The national Board of Directors of Rebuilding Together elected Gary Officer as the President and Chief Executive Officer. He replaces Patty Johnson, who retired in September after 22 years of service. Officer recently served as the President and CEO of Associated Black Charities where he was responsible for executive leadership for the nation's largest African-American philanthropic organization. Prior to that, he served as the President and CEO of the National Credit Union Foundation, Inc. where he oversaw the offices in Washington, DC and Madison, WI in addition to a national network of 22 state credit union foundations.

- **Neighbor•Care Update** - Our year-round program is well on its way to surpass the record set in 2005 for projects completed throughout Montgomery County. As of the end of September, 109 repairs were completed for 82 homeowners. Presently 26 repairs are in progress for 21 additional applicants. Neighbor•Care is currently focusing on performing home modifications for disabled homeowners.

- **2007 Group Work Camp** - Neighbor•Care will provide the supplies and identify 10 homeowners who will receive home repairs by work camp volunteers July 22-28, 2007. The program is administered by Stillwater Seventh Day Adventist Church in Vandalia.
